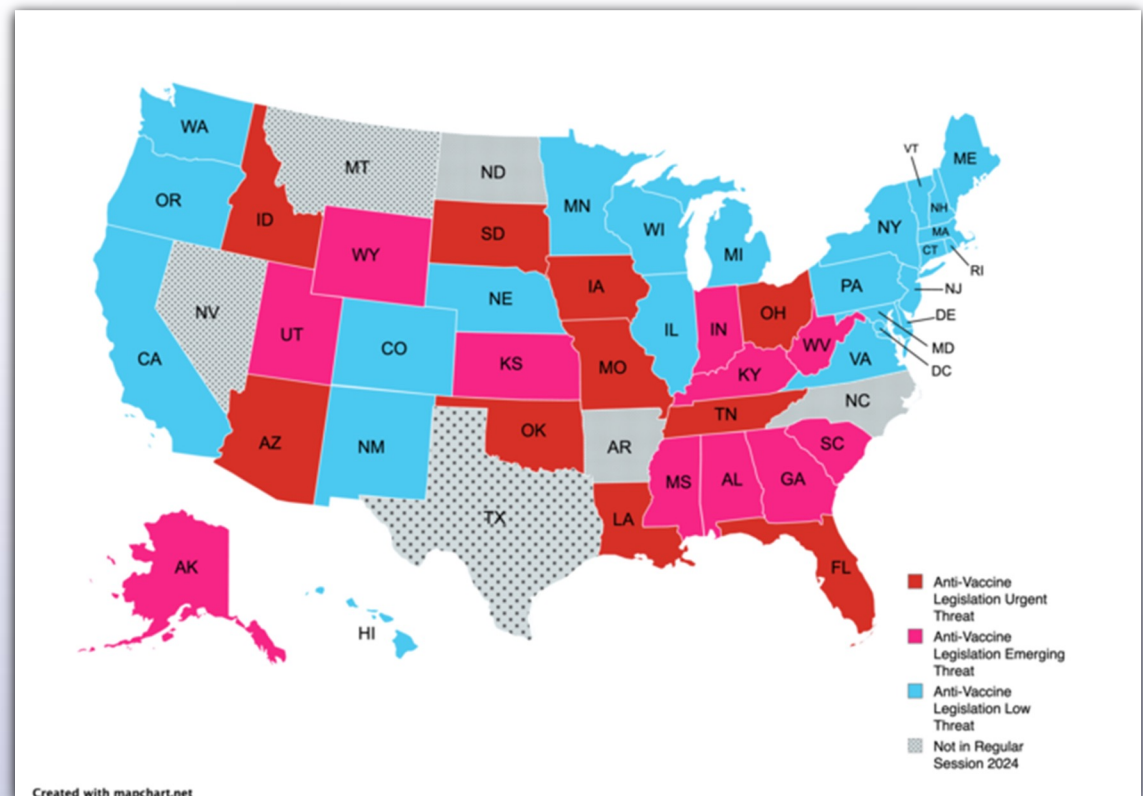
About IDPN

Within states, IDPN supports strong local voices that can sustainably defend and champion state-level vaccine policy. Our diverse allies include public health, patient groups, and private sector partners.

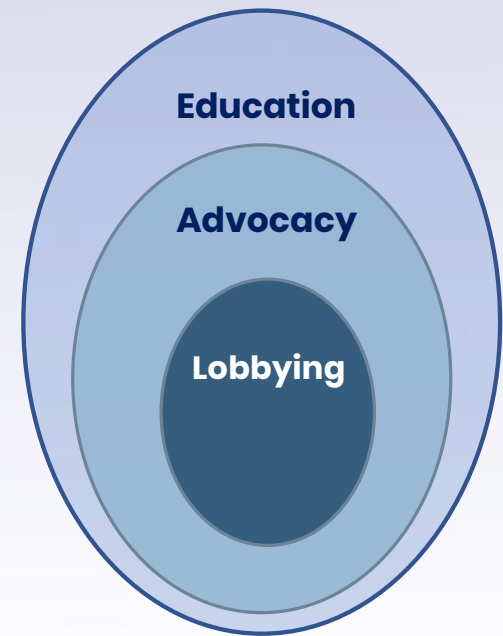


Education, Advocacy & Lobbying

Education includes sharing research & raising awareness about the effects of a specific policy on your cause or mission.

Advocacy is democracy in action. It is the expression of support for a cause, idea, or policy.

Lobbying can be either “direct lobbying” – asking a MOC to vote for or against a bill – or “grassroots lobbying” – mobilizing the public to contact MOCs to urge them to vote for or against a bill.



Ways to Drive Impact

- Identify strategies for who, where, when, how to influence
- Prepare in advance
- Engage with policy makers

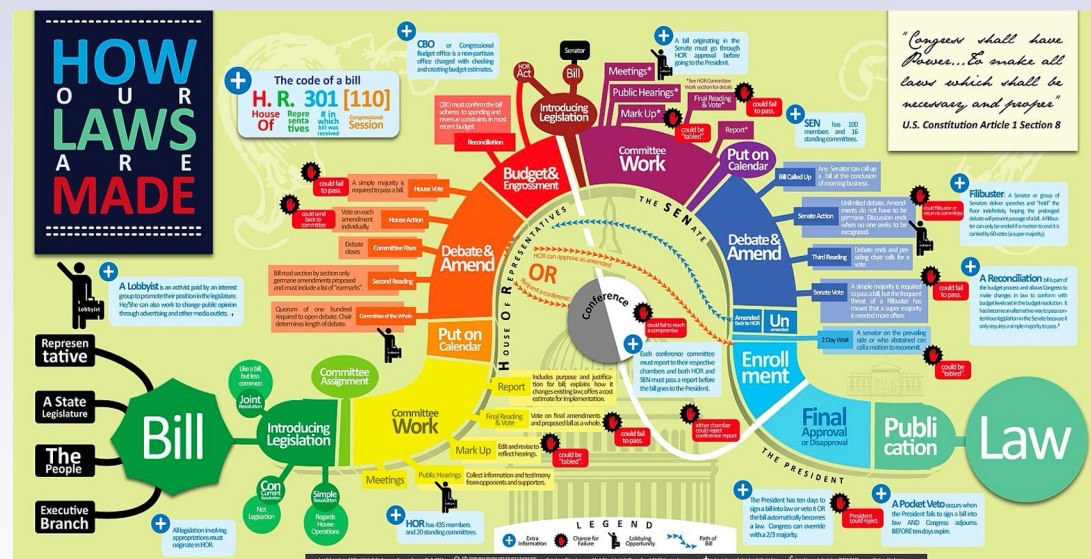
Why Advocate

Because...

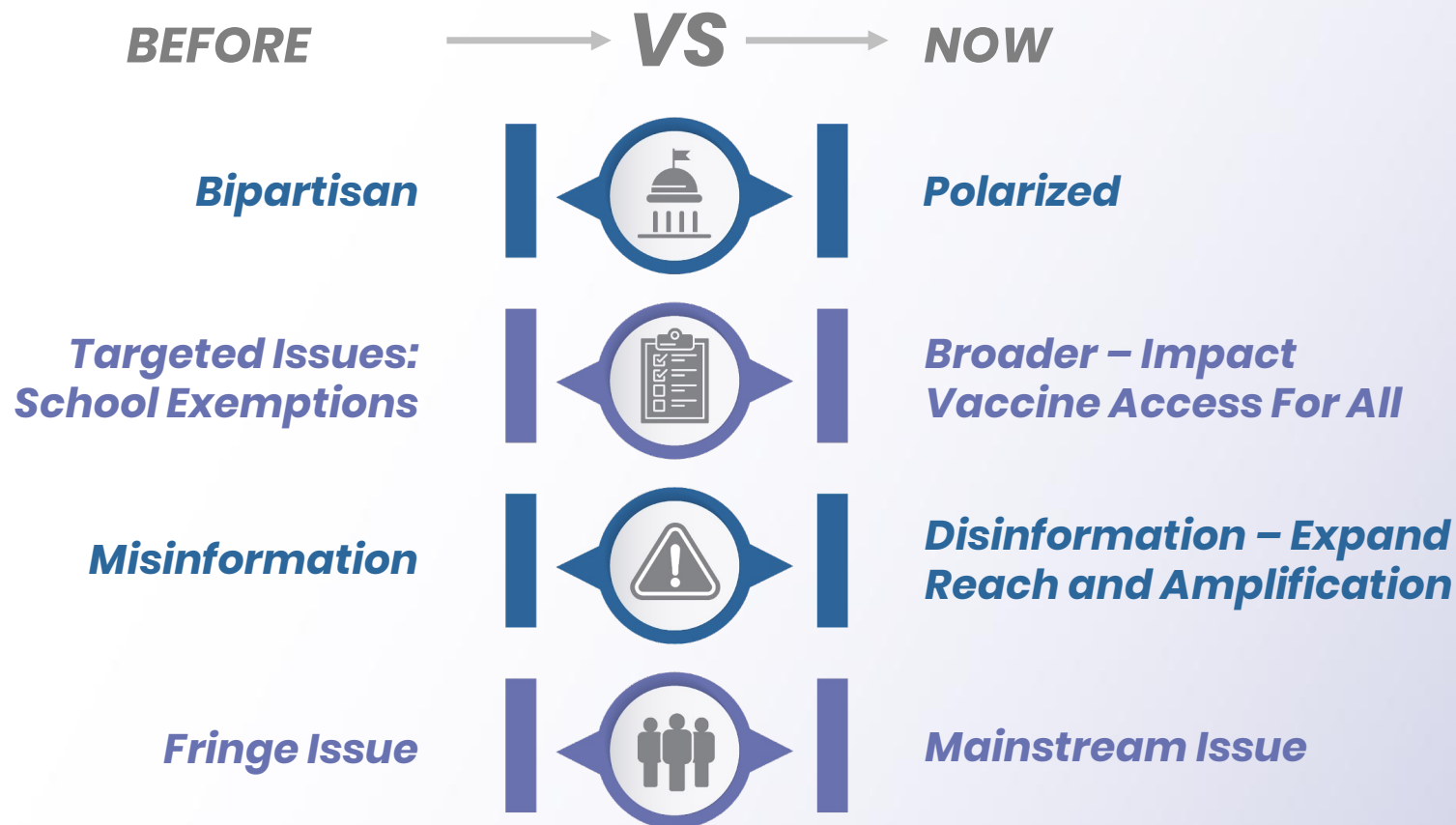
"People are much more likely to get angry when someone tries to take away something they have, than when they are denied something to which they aspire"

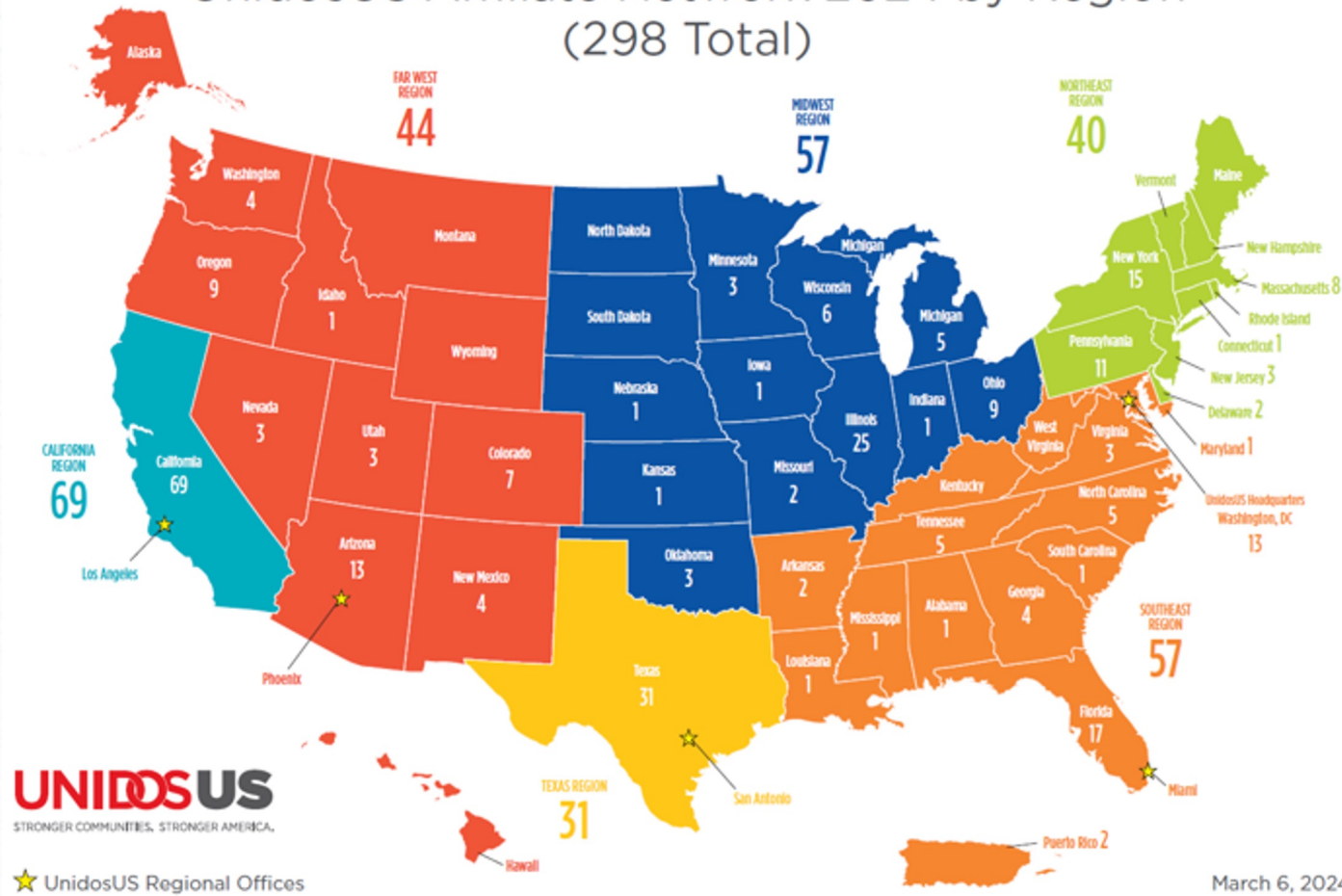

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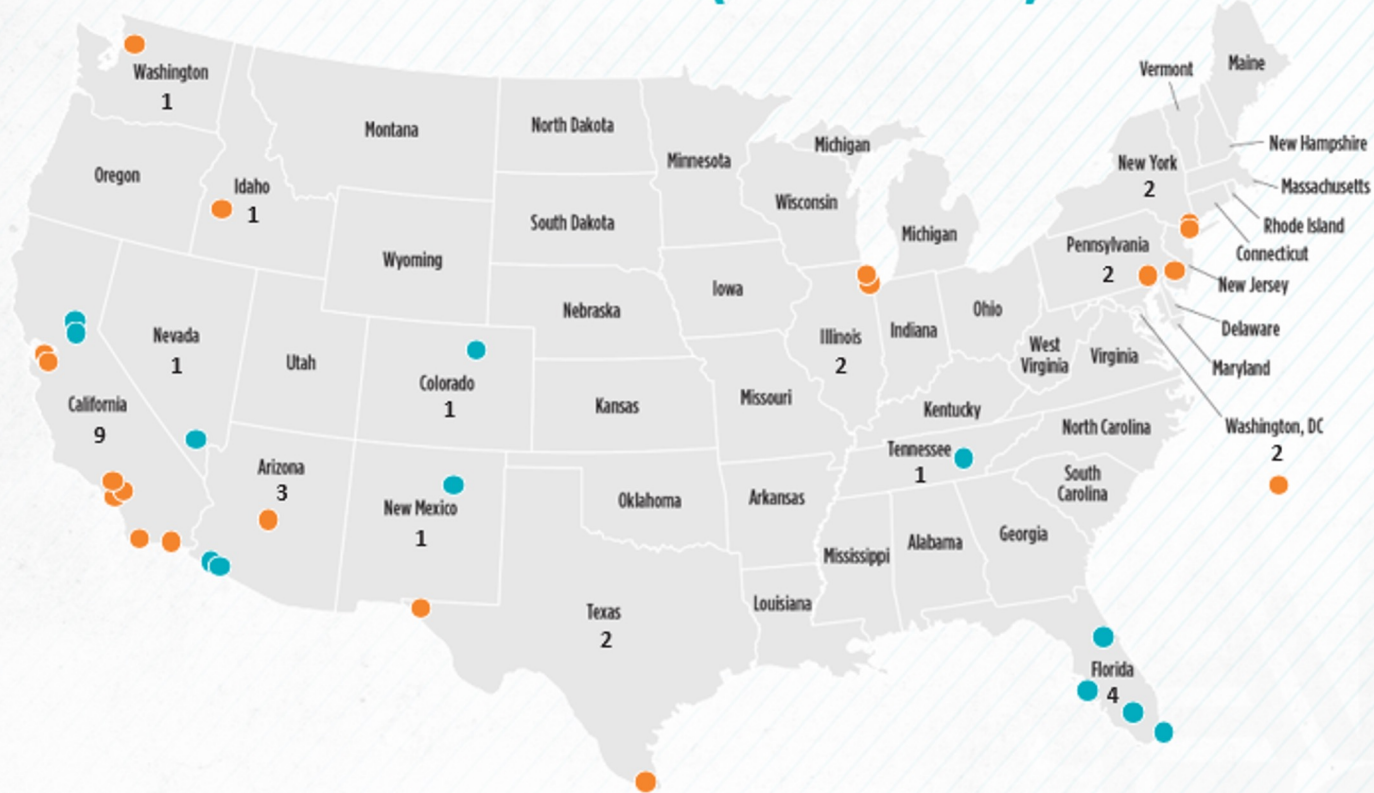
