



- Active local coalition since 1991
- Structure includes co-chairs, chair elect, steering committee and general members
- Members include 400+ diverse organizations
- Holds monthly steering committee meetings, bi-monthly general meetings, bi-annual summits, trainings, and webinars
- Participates in California Immunization Coalition meetings and events

The mission of SDIC is to increase immunization rates and improve the health of the residents of San Diego County by raising awareness and providing education about vaccine-preventable diseases.

Keys to Success for Local Coalitions



- Support from Local Health Department
- Key partner organizations (University of California, San Diego)
- Fiduciary mechanism

- Consistency in offering high-quality education & training opportunities with continuing education credits
- Partnerships with State leaders and local vaccination partners
