


Stories to Prevent COVID-19: Using stories to increase COVID-19 vaccine acceptance among pregnant and recent mothers

Introduction

- Pregnant and postpartum women are at an increased risk of severe COVID-19 illness but have lower rates of vaccination than the general adult population
- Strategies to improve vaccination include the use of trusted messengers to share information





Methods









Overview - Stories to Prevent (StoP) COVID-19 Pilot

We partnered with two WIC sites to record and test a video narrative intervention

- Recorded 5 videos which were developed using a narrative style of communication
- Recruited 96 pregnant and postpartum (gave birth since Jan. 2021) mothers to test intervention
- Conducted focus groups with 15 individuals







Results - StoP COVID-19 Pilot

Acceptability and Appropriateness



Information in the story is relevant to pregnant/postpartum mothers

Changes in COVID-19 Vaccine Attitudes

- \uparrow 11.3% The COVID-19 vaccine is effective.
- \downarrow 17.3% I am worried about the safety of the COVID-19 vaccine.



Expanded Project: Share Your Vaccine Story



16 WIC clinics



Mothers enrolled in WIC, WIC staff, health care professionals



10 videos



3 minutes with captions and animations


Other activities of this project include:

- Assembling a Community Advisory Board (CAB)
- Attending engagement events with participating WIC sites





Results: Impact so far







Participating Sites

- 18 WIC sites
- 17 counties



CAB

- 8 members
- 7 meetings



In-Person Events*

- 22 attended; 6 scheduled
- 1500+ community members reached
- 372 women completed video intervention and surveys

- 14 videos recorded
- 3 languages (English, Spanish, and Nepali)


